Topic: A Kingdom United



ICT

Make a short quiz (5–10 questions) to test your classmates on their knowledge of the UK.

Example questions:

- What is the capital of Wales?
- Who is the current monarch?
- Name one famous British landmark.

Maths

Imagine you are the new ruler of the United Kingdom. You've been given £1,000,000 to spend on your kingdom.

Tasks:

- Create a budget showing how you would spend the money. (e.g. £300,000 on schools, £250,000 on hospitals, £150,000 on parks...)

Drama

Imagine you are the king or queen of the United Kingdom.

Write (or record) a short speech to your people about how you will make your kingdom strong and united.

Extension: Practise performing it in a royal voice.

Geography

Print/draw and label a map of the United Kingdom.

Tasks:

- Label England, Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland
- Add the capital cities
- Decorate it with symbols or landmarks from each nation.

English/Research

Choose a famous British monarch (e.g., Queen Victoria) and create a fact file. Include:

- Dates they ruled
- Key events during their reign
- Fun facts about their life
- A small portrait or drawing
