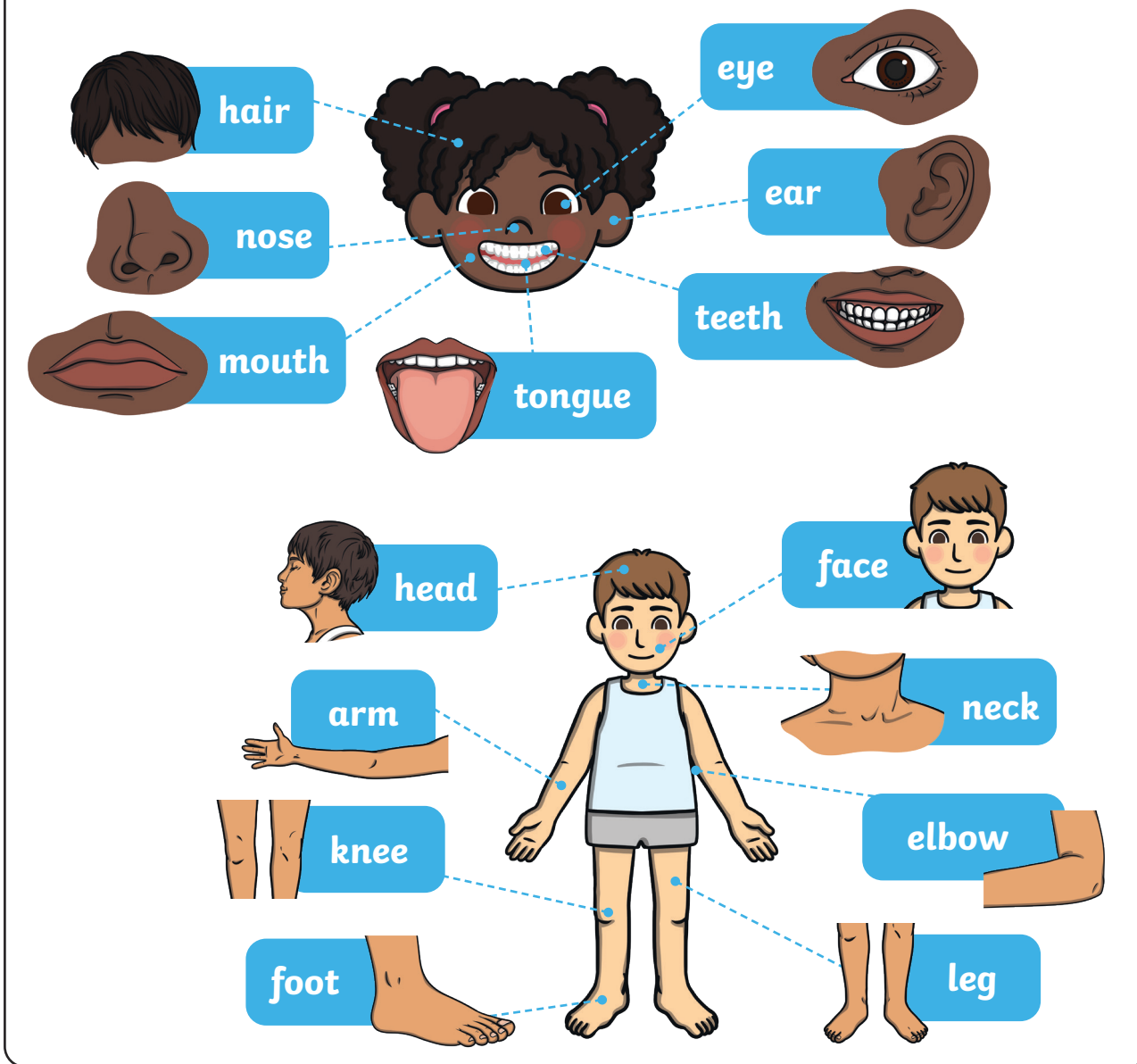






Key Vocabulary

<p>eyes</p>	<p>Eyes are a body part on the face. Humans see with their eyes.</p>
<p>ears</p>	<p>The ear is the body part that humans use to hear sounds.</p>
<p>nose</p>	<p>The nose is the part of the human body that is used to smell.</p>
<p>skin</p>	<p>Skin is what covers your body. You feel and touch with your skin.</p>
<p>tongue</p>	<p>The tongue is the part of the human body that is used to taste.</p>

sight	Sight is seeing things around you.
hearing	When you hear you are listening to sounds.
taste	Your tongue helps you know what things taste like.
touch	Your skin feels what things are like.
smell	When you smell something you use your nose.

smell	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Some smells are nice, like the smell of flowers. • Some smells are not so nice, like the smell of dirty socks!
