<b>Earth</b>	the name of the planet that we live on
<b>material</b>	what something is made of, such as wood or plastic
<b>recycle</b>	to change waste (like rubbish) into a material that can be used again
<b>reuse</b>	to use again
<b>plant</b>	a living thing that usually grows in soil and has leaves, roots and a stem
<b>animal</b>	a living creature that needs air, food, water and shelter
<b>helpful</b>	being kind and caring by helping someone or something
<b>harmful</b>	hurts someone or something

throwing rubbish on the ground

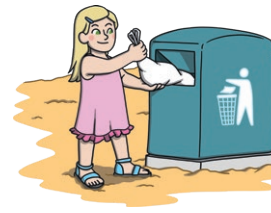


pulling up or stepping on **plants**
