## The Four Seasons

In a year, there are four **seasons**:



spring

summer

autumn

winter

## Weather in Spring

As the **season** changes from winter to **spring**, the **weather** also begins to change.



**Spring weather** can be quite mixed. Some days might be quite cold with **rain** and **wind**. Other days might be warmer with sunshine. There might also be **snow**.



## Nature in Spring

Trees that lost their leaves during winter grow new ones. Some plants grow blossom. New plants also begin to grow.



Animals become more active again so you may see more of them



Many baby animals are born during **spring**.

## Clothing in Spring

During **spring**, you might wear different kinds of clothing on different days as the **weather** can change a lot.



## Daylight in Spring

In **spring**, the amount of time in a day we have **daylight** for begins to get longer. It starts to get darker later in the evening and lighter earlier in the morning. The amount of time it is dark for at **night** becomes shorter.
