autumn

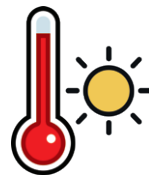
winter

## Weather in Summer

As the **season** changes from spring to **summer**, the **weather** also begins to change.

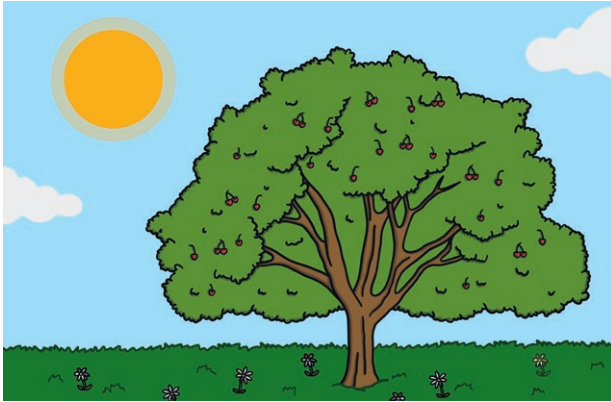


**Summer** is usually warmer than the other **seasons**. There may still be days in which it is colder, **rainy**, **windy** or **cloudy**.



## Nature in Summer

Deciduous trees are full of leaves. Lots of fruits and vegetables are ready to be harvested and many plants have flowers.



You may see more animals as many animals prefer the warmer **weather**.



Flowers attract insects such as butterflies and bees.

## Clothing in Summer

As the **weather** in **summer** can be very hot and **sunny**, you need to make sure you wear clothing that will keep you safe in the **sun**.



## Daylight in Summer

**Summer** has more **daylight** hours than any other **season**.

The amount of time it is dark for at night is shorter.
